NOTE: THE SECRETARY will move ahead of the Vice President and Mrs. Pence and be the first to greet Stephen Clark

9:25 AM - THE SECRETARY moves backstage and is greeted by the following NPS representatives:

- Robert Franz - Flight 93 National Memorial Park Ranger
- Adam Schaffer - Flight 93 National Memorial Acting Chief on Interpretation

NOTE: THE SECRETARY moves off stage to wreath laying area with Vice President Pence, Second Lady Karen Pence, and Gordon Felt. Speakers depart stage right.
