Dear Chair Drobnica and Council members,

The Office of Subsistence Management (OSM) fully supports outreach and engagement on Chum Salmon bycatch with affected Subsistence Regional Advisory Councils (Councils). Bycatch of salmon and other subsistence resources in the marine environment is an on-going concern for most of the 10 Councils, as expressed during Council meetings and through letters and comments previously provided to the North Pacific Fishery Management Council (NPFMC) and the Federal Subsistence Board.

OSM thanks the NPFMC members and staff for this forward-thinking plan to engage with the Councils following your February 2025 meeting. Our Council Coordinators look forward to the chance to collaborate with you and the Council Chairs to plan for effective outreach. We request that your staff reach out to the OSM Council Coordination Division as soon as possible to start developing tentative plans. As noted in the draft outreach plan, there is a very short turnaround between the February 2025 NPFMC meeting and the first Winter 2025 Council meetings (currently February 18-19 for the Bristol Bay Council and February 19-20 for the Eastern Interior Council). Due to the overlapping NPFMC and Council meetings in Fall 2025, we ask that outreach be prioritized for the Councils' Winter 2025 meeting cycle.

OSM was made aware of the draft Outreach and Engagement Plan on Chum Salmon Bycatch by one of our Council members a few days ahead of the public comment deadline. We kindly ask that NPFMC staff notify OSM directly about plans, even if tentative, that involve or impact our
