Dear Representative Maloney,

The 21st Century IDEA Section 3, subparagraph (b) (2) requires the head of each executive agency that maintains a website or digital service that is made available to the public to submit to Congress a report that includes (A) a list of websites or digital services maintained by the executive agency that are most viewed or utilized by the public or are otherwise important for public engagement, (B) from among the websites and digital services listed under the subparagraph (A), a prioritization of websites and digital services that require modernization to meet the requirements under subsection (a) of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) Act, and (C) an estimate of the cost and schedule of modernization the websites and digital services prioritized under subparagraph (B).

The Department of Interior (DOI) Office of Communications (OCO), with input from the DOI Web Council, identified 16 department websites that are most viewed or utilized by the public or are otherwise important for public engagement. Of those 16 websites, 7 are fully modernized; 4 have been modernized, but still contain some PDF content that is not Section 508 compliant; 1 is currently undergoing modernization activities; and 4 are scheduled to be modernized before Fiscal Year 2021. Please find additional details in the attached document.
