Subject: COVID-19 Policy Bulletin 2022-2: Updated Guidance for Meetings, Conferences,

Events, Trainings, and Social Gatherings of 50 or More Participants

The purpose of this Department of the Interior COVID-19 Policy Bulletin is to provide current policy regarding hosting in-person meetings, conferences, events, trainings, or social gatherings (indoor or outdoor) that will be attended by 50 or more participants – regardless of whether participants include members of the public.

With the continuing COVID-19 pandemic impact to operations, the Department created this policy bulletin based on current guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Safer Federal Workforce Task Force to help Bureaus and Offices prioritize the safety and wellbeing of employees, partners, and visitors at in-person events where 50 or more participants are expected to attend.
