Dear Secretary Jewell,

Hope you're having a great start to the year. As you likely know, the board of directors of the Yellowstone Association and the Yellowstone Park Foundation have agreed to merge organizations. This newly created organization, with a working name of "New Yellowstone," will begin operating jointly in March 2016. The merger creates a single non-profit organization of more than 50,000 supporters and will serve the combined mission of connecting people to Yellowstone through outstanding visitor experiences and educational programs, as well as translating those experiences into lifelong support and philanthropic investment.

Reporting to the new Board of Directors, the President of New Yellowstone will have responsibility for the day-to-day management of the organization including strategic, programmatic, fiscal and operational accountability. S/he will work to integrate the staff, operations, systems and procedures across the two current geographies, in Bozeman and Gardiner, MT, and build a culture that recognizes one organization supporting the Park with a broad and bold mission. S/he will work in partnership with the Superintendent and Park staff and the Board to drive the long-term strategy and achieve ambitious goals on behalf of Yellowstone National Park.

We've attached the position specification here, and would welcome any potential candidate recommendations you may have.
