Directions to City from Las Vegas:

1. Take I-15 North through Las Vegas to US 93, exit 64 (roughly 21 miles out of Las Vegas).
2. Take 93 North to junction with NV 318 (roughly 85 miles, about 1 hour 10 min). We recommend topping off the gas tank in Alamo or Ash Springs.
3. Turn Left onto NV 318 Right and stay to the Right as the highway splits after 0.6 miles. Continue for 16.7 miles to Seaman Wash Road.
4. Turn left onto Seaman Wash Road (dirt/gravel). Follow the road 29.2 miles through Coal Valley and into Water Gap.
5. Turn left onto Timber Mtn Pass Road and head West for 2.4 miles to junction with private road to City.


