Public hearing regarding mountain goat management in Unit 4

SITKA, Alaska – The Sitka District Ranger, under authority granted by the Federal Subsistence Board, will hold a public meeting and hearing to share information and solicit comments to help guide Federal subsistence mountain goat management in <u>Unit 4</u>.
