



Tribal Request to Research Records at AIRR

The Office of Trust Records stores Tribal records at the American Indian Records Repository (AIRR), in Lenexa, Kansas.

To research Tribal records, a Research Request (IARM Form 4001) must be completed and faxed to the AIRR at (913) 356-2685.

The individuals submitting the request must be authorized by the Tribe.

Remember to answer all questions and sign the document!

The AIRR researcher will contact the Tribal requester within one business day of the receipt of the research request by phone or fax regarding the status of the research request.

The Tribal requester will receive a response letter informing of the results of the research with copies of the findings.
